Towse has been featured in Voyage LA and Rock & Real magazines, has supported artists such as Jon Gomm and has played at storied venues such as the Troubadour in LA and Old Blue Last in London. Grace Fellows (lead singer/songwriter) synthesized her broad musical influences and dug deep while studying experimental-pop at Calarts, and in doing her masters at BIMM London, she polished her craft and grew into the vulnerably captivating performer she is today.

Virtuoso violinist, Corwin Zekley (+backup vox & percussion) was born with a fiddle in their hands and plays with an intensity yet delicacy that pulls on the heartstrings of all who hear them.
